

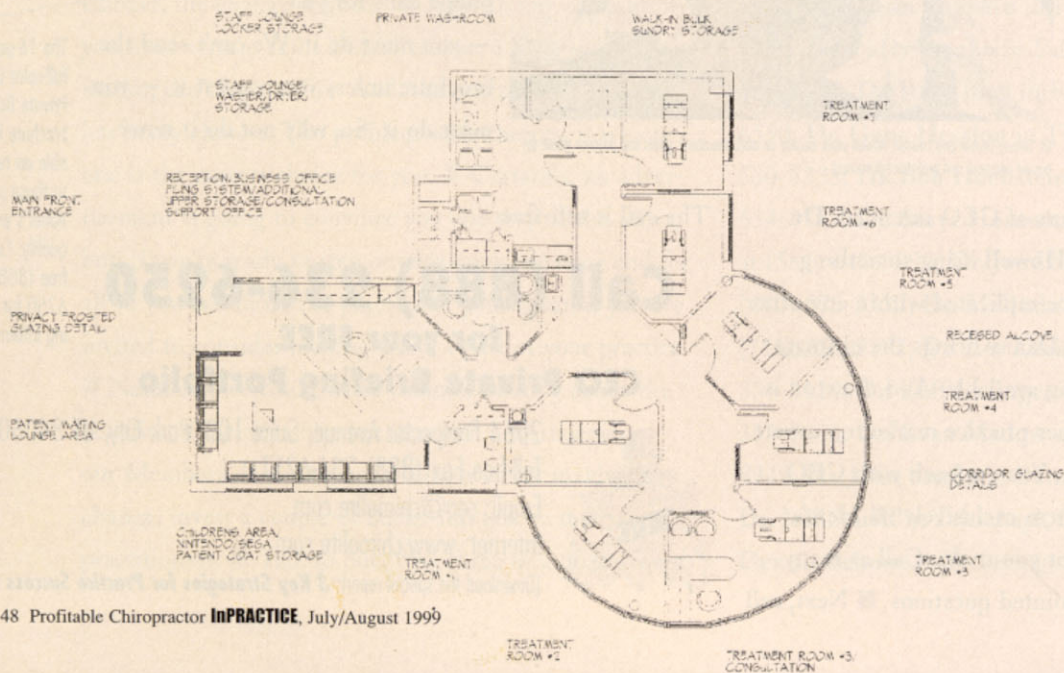

# Architectural Winners The Best of the Best



### Points of interest:

- ▲ All interior wall construction is 3 5/8" steel stud or 2"x4"
- ▲ All stud walls continue to underside of structure to have top track to minimize deflection
- ▲ Wood frame construction, all walls to be full height to T-bar and drywall ceilings
- ▲ All partitions are located on center of ceiling grid
- ▲ Light-tight connect
